SHORT COURSE ON SAFARI GUIDING

16 – 28 AUGUST 2021

Introduction

The Government of Tanzania through the Ministry of Natural Resources and Tourism is implementing a countrywide system of tour guides registration, certification and accreditation in compliance with the Tourism Act No. 11 of 2008, section 42 when read together with Tourism (Tour Guides) Regulations, 2013 and Guidelines on Registration and Licensing of Tourism Operators. The Act stipulates that tour guides should be registered, certified and licensed after attending an appropriate training in order to operate in the tourism industry. In respect to this, the College of African Wildlife Management, Mweka (CAWM) has planned a two weeks short course for Safari Guides. The training will be conducted through lectures and field practical training in Iringa Region and Ruaha National Park.

The course will cover the following areas:

1. Tourism and Protected Areas
2. Protected Areas Biological Resources Identification and General Ecology
3. Protected Areas Physical Resources Interpretation
4. Tour Guiding Skills and Techniques
5. Communication Skills and Customer Care
6. First Aid, Emergency Care and Wilderness Rescue
7. Basics of Firearms

Entry Qualifications:

1. At least Ordinary Certificate of Secondary Education (OCSE) or above;
2. Be a member of any recognized Safari Guides Association in Tanzania;
3. At least two (2) years working experience as Safari Guide for male applicants

Cost of Training and Payment Modality
