APPLICATION MODE

- i. You will be required to complete your application through the College online admission system which can be accessed through the link admission.mwekawildlife.ac.tz. This link can also be accessed through the College website www.mwekawildlife.ac.tz
- ii. If you are a new applicant, use "application for long courses" and then "Register" link to begin the application process. Then follow the steps to complete your application.
- iii. If you already have an account, enter your form four Index Number (username) and Password to login in the link "registered applicant"
- iv. After successful login to your account, you will see a Control number displayed on your screen for application fee payment.
- v. After successful paying the application fee, complete the application form and submit.
- vi. The application fee is 10,000 TZS for Certificate and Diploma programmes, and 20,000 TZS for Postgraduate Diploma and Master's programmes. The fee is non-refundable.
- vii. Payments can also be done through Mobile Money (Tigo-Pesa, M-pesa, Airtel Money and Halo-pesa)
